#### **Bank Bar**

#### **Tap Station**

An import from the old Manila area, the Tap Station on Burgos Circle offers an extensive line-up of local and imported beers, including an impressive 25 craft beers on tap to choose from.



#### LIT Whisky Bar

LIT Manila in Serendra has the most extensive selection of Japanese whiskey in the Philippine capital. Inside the cosy interior, a long wooden bar is surrounded by shelves stacked with rare bottles from different parts of the world. LIT also organises regular tasting sessions for whisky aficionados who want to sample the best Scottish single malts, while funky grooves are played by resident DJs.

#### **Reserve Gastro Tavern**

Always crowded and located in the heart of Burgos Circle Reserve Gastro Tavern is an American restaurant and bar offering lunch, dinner, classic bar chows and comfort food until late at night.





#### The Brewery at the Palace

This on-site microbrewery may be one of the most unique places to drink in Manila. The sprawling two-storey space showcases massive steel machinery from which its newly-produced beer is served. The Brewery adheres to German brewing standards, offering the freshest pilsner, wheat, IPA and stout on tap. They also specialize in serving great pub grubs. The Brewery is open for lunch at 11am until 2am serving meals around the clock. They have a wide range of seafood and meat main dishes as well as soups and salads, pasta, pizza, and burgers. A great one-stop destination for great bears, awesome food in sharing portions, and live entertainment.

#### **Tipsy Pig**

The Tipsy Pig is known for its signature cocktails and *pulutan* (bar snacks). The Tipsy boneless crispy pata (deep-fried pigs knuckles with Asian soy garlic chili sauce) is a crowd favorite, ideally downed with an ice-cold beer.



### NIGHTCLUBS

### Xylo at the Palace

Xylo is one of the hottest clubs on the block. Formerly known as Valkyrie, the stylishly-renovated venue is gaining a steady reputation for bringing top European DJs to Manila. What goes down inside is a mix of foreigners and yuppies alike living a lush life while walled with the trendiest EDM, mashed Hip Hop and Pop remixes that will make you lose it! Tickets for special acts always come with a free drink. It is best to book in advance to get the best deals.



#### **Revel at the Palace**

The Revel masters the art of luxury clubbing, with an impressive lighting and sound system and lush interiors oozing decadence. Such is its reputation, it can hold its own with some of the top nightclubs in Las Vegas. It offers impeccable service, a selection of spirits and specialty cocktails and top DJs flown in from all over the world. The two-level venue rocks until sunrise. If you'd like something more private, reserve a sofa on the mezzanine.

Also, a great choice if you're looking for a more mature club than Xylo.



### The Island

Completing the Uptown BGC nightlife list, The Island has a more tropical feel of a club with a selection of mini-bars and different food stalls. The palm trees, beachside colors and summer-y vibe all puts a refreshing look. Plus, it isn't called 'The Island' for nothing. Spot the huge pool in the middle and it instantly reminds you of the Philippines' 107 islands.



### ROOFTOPS

#### Straight Up at the Seda Hotel

At the hotel Seda Bonifacio Global City rooftop you will find this amazing cocktail bar and lounge, with a luxurious and modern interior and one of the best views in the city. Serving a good selection of classic cocktails, crafted beers and an extensive wine list, this is the perfect place for pre-dinner cocktails or just drinks, lounge vibes and views chatting with friends and colleagues. The intimate terrace comes with a chill mix between house, 80s and 90s remakes, sometimes replaced with live

entertainment.





#### The Peak at the Grand Hyatt

A music lounge, a rooftop grill restaurant, and a multi-level bar in one, The Peak definitely raised the bar, as it happens to also offer a grand 360-view from the tallest building in the Philippines. The Peak is Grand Hyatt Manila rooftop bar perched on the skyscraper's 60th to 62nd floors. The concept is 'inspired by "penthouse living", one space flows seamlessly into, up to, and down to another..' It features a lively music bar and serves a long list of whiskies and handcrafted beverages that can be well paired with their tempting steaks and grilled dishes.

## TRACK 30TH

BGC Greenway Park is the longest urban park in Metro Manila spanning one mile (1.6 km) of asphalt road surrounded by grass and trees.

It's a good place to run uninterrupted in BGC away from all of the stoplights, cars, pedestrians, and bikers without having the hassle of stopping at every corner. At night, the entire route is well lit with street lights.

Greenway Park is arguably the best place for runners to run straight back and forth, while easily counting the miles.

### **#1: CONVENIENCE**

Everything in BGC is within walking distance to each other so using a car is not needed for 99% of residents staying primarily in the city. Combined with the many grocery stores, western infrastructure, and accessibility to imported goods, BGC offers convenience at its finest.

### **#2: WESTERNIZED**

The first thing most expats notice about BGC is how westernized it is in comparison to the other cities in Manila. The city is clean, there's no shortage of international establishments, and English is spoken by practically everyone in the city.

BGC is also the only major city in the Philippines to be free of crowded power lines!





#### **#3: LESS TRAFFIC & POLLUTION**

Due to the wide streets and sidewalks, well thought out infrastructure, and western influenced development planning, the traffic in BGC is much less of a problem than that of other cities in Manila and Cebu.

In addition to that, the greenery, landscaping, and many trees contribute to the lower levels of pollution in the city. So needless to say, congestion in BGC is not a factor to worry about.

### #4: FLOOD FREE

The BGC development features an all-underground utility system, keeping the streets orderly and decent looking for the public. It also features an on-site flood mitigation facility using storm water management and a sustainable urban drainage system to reduce flood peaks at the downstream areas of the development.



### #5: STRONG WIFI

The Philippines is well known to have not only some of the slowest wifi speeds in the world, but also the most expensive. BGC on the other hand delivers fast and reliable wifi especially in comparison to the provinces of the Philippines.

### #6: PEDESTRIAN FRIENDLY
